Thank you so much for your continued efforts in providing this most welcome drink at the end of Mass. It is welcomed by many in our parish community and is a wonderful vehicle for extending the hand of friendship to old and new parishioners.

The boiler can be filled from the new sink just opposite the toilet. Whilst you are doing that you could switch on the water boiler above the sink so that you can fill the flask. I would recommend that you use the flask to fill the teapot as holding the teapot under the boiler tap can get a bit hot! There is an extension lead which plugs into the wall in the porch. Supplies of cups and biscuits are kept in the bottom cupboard on the right in the kitchen upstairs or under the sink downstairs. Please notify the parish secretary if there is a need to buy any supplies.

All monies collected should be put in a plastic cup and put on the secretary's desk in the office with a note to say 'coffee money'. The table used is behind the back bench on the left hand side of the church. For health and safety reasons can I suggest that you use a separate small table for the children's drinks and biscuits, there is one stored in the cupboard near to the library.

Can you please make sure that the trolley is left clean and tidy. Two members of the choir very kindly 'Hoover' or should I say 'Kirby' up for us after Mass, we are most grateful to them for doing so.

If you can recruit any other parishioners to help with coffee I would be very grateful. Any problems or suggestions please feedback so that we can deal with them. Kind regards Ann Campion
